

## **WELCOME IN SILESIA**

Dear All,

On behalf of the Polish Lacrosse Federation and the Polish Women's National Team, we would like to invite you to an international women's lacrosse tournament that will take place in Katowice and Chorzów in Poland. The event is scheduled at the turn of June and July 2017. It is planned as a 10 day happening, during which two separate tournaments will occur – New Comers and Coal Cup.

The first one will run from 26.06 to 28.06.2017 and is intended for newly formed club teams from all over Europe. For this tournament we have a limit of 10 spots, the entry fee is 500 euro. Thus, we kindly ask to pass on our offer to all female clubs in Europe.

The second tournament is planned from 29.06 to 4.07 and it's for national teams. At the time of creating this offer, we received a preliminary application from 6 teams, yet we aim to have up to 10 national teams. The amount of the entry fee is 2000 euro, all of which will be spent on the organization of the competition, awards, referees etc.

We hope for your positive response to this offer, which is completely under the patronage of the European Lacrosse Federation.

## **ORGANISERS**

## LOCATION

The host of the event is AZS Legion Katowice in cooperation with the Polish Lacrosse Federation and European Lacrosse Federation. The organization of the ELF Challenge: Coal Cup is supported by the city of Katowice, Marshal of Silesia the Ministry of Sport and Tourism.

Chairman of the organising committee is the vice president of Polish Lacrosse Federation and manager of the Polish National Women's Team, Dawid Wójcik.

Partners activities are also companies - we4u.com.pl, Centrum Reklamy Silesia, Czerwinski Trans and Dawcy Zdrowia - responsible for the medical care of all teams.

Katowice and Chorzow are a cities located in the central part of the province. Due to the high rate of urbanization, cities are highly developed. Great infrastructure provides a very good communication between the sports facilities and hotel buildings.

Katowice has international airport (Pyrzowice) away from the city center about a half hour drive. In addition, nearby are located two other airports - Balice (68 km) and Ostrava (111 km).

The event will be played at the Silesian Stadium, which will host the team to measure for the first three places. In 2017 it is planned to put into operation completely modernized facility. Side pitches have high quality surfaces - synthetic and natural, being able to accommodate a total of about 1,000 spectators.





## **EVENT**

#### **ELF Challenge: Coal Cup**

The suggested dates for ELF Challenge: Coal Cup are 26.06 – 4.07.2017.

Earlier dates are not possible due to national league competitions, and immediately after our events are planned The World Games in Wrocław.

We expect participation from 10 teams. All games can be played simultaneously on two pitches. A meeting of the medal zone will take place on the main board of the Silesian Stadium.

In addition, we have a third pitch, which can serve as a facility for training and friendlies.

#### Meals


Meals are served in Diament Hotels, located 50 and 500 meters from venues. Teams can also arrange their own meals at hotel or several restaurants of the city.



# TRANSPORT & COMMUNICATION

Katowice and Chorzow are well communicated with each other. You can easily navigate within them both on foot and I using public transport.

All participants of the Coal Cup will receive free passage for communication system, so that tourism will be even easier.

The distance between the hotels of the pitch are respectively 50 and 500 meters away and the center is about 5km, 15 minutes by tram.



**Conference rooms** - to disposal of the participants will be given to conference rooms in hotels, so prepare teams for the next games will be even easier. It does not generate any additional costs for the team.

**Internet** - on both fields will be wireless internet. LAN connection is only used for live streaming games and WLAN will be password secured for media, organizers and ELF representatives to use.

**Game recording and live stream** - each live stream will be free to watch online with English commentary. All meetings will be recorded and available free of charge for the teams. In addition, the highlights will be created, posted on the website of the event for a few hours after the game.

**Live statistics** - We recognize that people want to follow their favourite team and know the results of the games real time. We will offering live statistics from all games on our website.


**Referees** - 25 referees who will appear on the championship, will receive from our federation accommodation at a hotel, full board, as well as payment for their duties.

**Tauron Nowa Muzyka** - the combination of jazz and modern electronic sounds. Every year gathers thousands of fans. The event takes place in August.








## REGION

#### Kraków:

Krakow is a city in the Malopolska province, a distance of only 70 km from Katowice (A4 motorway). One of the most famous Polish cities, having a rich history dating back to the tenth century. For historical reasons, there is a lot of monuments; great market, Royal Castle, Cloth Hall, St. Mary's Church. Moreover, Krakow is also a city which hosts international events and festivals. The varied range of sports and cultural causes that everyone will find something there for everyone.

#### Oświęcim:

Auschwitz-Birkenau is a place of memory, a symbol of the Nazi extermination of-the Holocaust. The team of German Nazi concentration camps, including the extermination camp in Auschwitz and the nearby village, the existing 1940-1945.

#### **Beskid Slaski:**

Mountain range in the south of the province of Silesia. The highest peak is Skrzyczne (1257 m. Above the sea level). At the foot of the mountains is also a lake Żywieckie. Ideal place for long hikes.

#### Zator:

Energylandia - Family amusement park located in Zator. The largest amusement park in Poland with an area of approx. 26 hectares. The park is divided into four thematic zones a total of approx. 60 attractions designed for all ages, including seven roller coasters, numerous rides and equipment extreme, as well as restaurants, bars, souvenir shops and scenes, which are presented briefly show .
